The Network/Website Analyst is responsible for providing skilled technical work in the implementation, maintenance, and analysis of network systems and components, and the design, maintenance and support of websites. Work is performed under the supervision of the Information Systems Manager or other supervisor. The Network/Website Analyst is responsible to monitor, configure, analyze and troubleshoot network performance (LAN, WAN, and wireless networks) and ensure optimum efficiency and stable operation of all data delivery processes, wired and wireless systems network infrastructure, storage and server platforms.

Thorough knowledge of network design, systems, protocols, and applications; Thorough knowledge of networking products, configuration and management to include routers, firewalls and switches; Thorough knowledge of the tools, techniques, and methods utilized for the resolution of networking issues; Thorough knowledge of current versions of Windows server management, Windows operating systems, Windows office software, including Microsoft 365; Thorough knowledge of the principles, practices and methods of internet filtering; Thorough knowledge of video conferencing and other methods to facilitate communication; Thorough knowledge of the principles, practices and methods of website design and development, including alignment, hierarchy, proximity, balance, color, and space. Thorough knowledge of current software utilized in website design, editing, and maintenance.

Minimum Qualification: Attainment of a minimum of a bachelor's degree in computer science, mathematics, or closely related field and a minimum of three years responsible technical experience in the installation, repair, maintenance, and support of a complex enterprise network environment, including or supplemented by a minimum of one year experience in web development and maintenance; or a combination of education and experience equivalent to these requirements.
