Summary of Job Duties

Perform a wide variety of journeyman level plumbing, electrical, and carpentry building and equipment maintenance and repair work. Oversee and participate in the installation and repair of water and sewer lines and other maintenance and repair projects in which more than one person is required. Assist in training new employees and directing the work of less skilled employees. Prepare records of work performed and supplies used, using an I-Pad. Periodically, serve as worker on call for emergency calls during periods in which no one is scheduled to work, such as nights, weekends, and holidays.

Minimum Qualifications

High school diploma or GED Certification plus three years of building or apartment maintenance work that included electrical, plumbing and carpentry work, or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Certification as Universal Technician (EPA Card) preferred. **NOTE:** This job requires the incumbent to be periodically on call, 24 hours per day, for a seven-day period.

Ability to be insured under the Authority's vehicle policy
