Communicate and coordinate with the Maintenance Supervisor in planning and setting priorities regarding property conditions, work orders, vacancies, and any other needed area regarding the Multifamily units to achieve goals that meet or exceed HUD standards. Brief the Executive Director on all the above-mentioned communication/coordination. Assist in the community to further the betterment of THA residents, as requested by the Executive Director.

Bachelor's degree in management, business administration, social science area, or closely related field plus 3 years of progressively responsible experience in public housing, or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Experience in property management and experience involving public contact is preferred.
